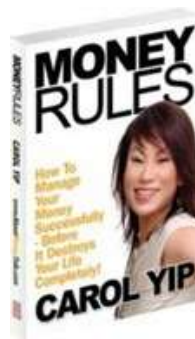
Profile of Carol Yip
